

3 Broadband Unlimited

1. The following terms and conditions of the 3 Broadband Unlimited price plan (the "Plan") are in addition to and form part of the terms and conditions of the Three Ireland (Hutchison) Limited ("Three") terms of service available at <https://www.three.ie/pdf/Small-Print.pdf>. In the event of any conflict the terms and conditions below shall prevail.

Minimum Term

2. The Plan is subject to a minimum term of 24 months. The minimum price for the services provided under your Three agreement is the cost of the Plan monthly recurring charge of €29.99 for the minimum term.

3. If you cancel the Agreement during the minimum term you agree to pay a cancellation fee calculated by multiplying the Plan monthly recurring charge of €29.99 (inclusive of VAT) by the number of months or part months remaining in your minimum term. This cancellation fee will not apply for any cancellation you make within 14 days of entering into the agreement where you have entered into a distance contract, ie via three.ie or over the phone.

4. When the Plan minimum term has expired, we will supply you with Three Services until you advise us that you wish to cancel your Agreement. If you wish to cancel your agreement after the Plan minimum term has expired, you can end your agreement by giving 30 days written or phone notice to us via 1913 and no cancellation fees will apply.

Allowance

5. A monthly data usage allowance of 750 gigabytes (GB) per month applies to the Plan.

Charging

6. The out of bundle rate applicable after the 750GB is consumed is 6.15c per megabyte (MB).

No carryover

7. Any unused data allowance of the Plan 750GB monthly allowance will not be carried forward to the next bill cycle.

No Roaming

6. Data Roaming is excluded from the Plan. For the avoidance of doubt the Plan will only work within the Republic of Ireland. The Plan is not a mobile offering and accordingly it does not fall within the scope of Regulation (EU) No 531/2012 (the Roaming Regulations).

7. The Plan is subject to Three network coverage and availability.
